OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Support Arizona “Get US Out! of the UN” Resolution HM 2001

A resolution calling on Congress to *Get US Out!* of the UN has been introduced in the Arizona State Legislature. ***Call your state representatives, and urge them to support this important resolution!***

House Memorial 2001 ([HM 2001](#)) is sponsored by Representative Khyll Powell (R-Gilbert). It notes that “the U.N. often pursues an agenda that is counteractive to the policy goals of the United States,” continuing:

Whereas, other U.N. initiatives threaten the sovereignty of the United States, such as the Law of the Sea Treaty, the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the Arms Trade Treaty; and

Whereas, the U.N.’s decision-making imposes restrictions on individual nations, stripping them of their autonomy, and usurps the people’s right to self-governance.

The resolution concludes by calling on “the President of the United States and the United States Congress [to] withdraw from the United Nations to better serve this country’s interests.”

The policies emanating from the UN are antithetical to the American form of government. For example, the UN’s [Agenda 21/2030](#) plan seeks [total control](#) and regimentation of the entire planet, and prominent examples of its implementation include the [global war on farmers](#), [carbon-capture pipelines](#), and the [transition toward “green” energy](#). The global body’s “[Summit of the Future](#)” advocated more power for the UN.

It is essential that the U.S. president and Congress *Get US Out!* of the UN — and state legislatures can play a key role in putting pressure on Congress. ***Contact your state representatives, and urge them to support HM 2001.***
