



Dr. Joe Wolverton II, J.D., Constitutional Law Scholar for The John Birch Society, explains what's wrong with the so-called "SAVE Act" that is widely popular among conservatives, who hope it will prevent illegal aliens from voting in U.S. elections. Dr. Wolverton, who read the 26-page proposed legislation, gives a deep-dive explanation of everything that's wrong with it, and why true conservatives and guardians of the Constitution ought to oppose it — based on federalism and states' rights.
